## Red Hot Chili Peppers

Note 1: The hi-hat in the verses is played loosely, with a slight accent on the downbeats. (notated only in the 1st measure).

Note 2: The ghosted snare doubles are technically more like 16th triplets than like 32nd note drags. Both work for playing along.

### VERSE

Drum notation for Verse 1, measures 1-4. The first measure includes a hi-hat symbol and a triplet of eighth notes. The dynamic is *mp*. Lyrics: "Psychic spies..." and "Edge of the world..."

Drum notation for Verse 1 continuation, measures 5-8. Includes triplet markings and a '0' marking. Lyrics: "Pay your surgeon very well..." and "First born unicorn..."

### PRECHORUS

Drum notation for Prechorus 1, measures 1-4. Includes a 'R' marking and triplet markings. The dynamic is *mf*. Lyrics: "Pay your surgeon very well..." and "First born unicorn..."

Drum notation for Prechorus 2, measures 5-8. Includes a 'L' marking and triplet markings. The dynamic is *f*. Lyrics: "Marry me girl..." and "Space may be the final frontier..."

### CHORUS

Drum notation for Verse 2, measures 1-4. Includes triplet markings. The dynamic is *mp*. Lyrics: "Marry me girl..." and "Space may be the final frontier..."

Drum notation for Verse 2 continuation, measures 5-8. Includes triplet markings and a '0' marking. Lyrics: "Born and raised..." and "First born unicorn..."

### PRECHORUS

Drum notation for Prechorus 3, measures 1-4. Includes triplet markings. The dynamic is *mf*. Lyrics: "Born and raised..." and "First born unicorn..."

Drum notation for Prechorus 4, measures 5-8. Includes triplet markings. The dynamic is *f*. Lyrics: "Born and raised..." and "First born unicorn..."
